## **Introduction**

This data file includes all candidate-level results for the Swiss Council of States elections, from 1967 to 2003. Results from earlier elections are also available for some cantons. We relied on the results collected by the Parliament services, which are available online in pdf format (see link below). But the present data file contains a few additional or recoded variables. A variable and labels list can be found below.

Each observation corresponds to one candidate in a given round of a given election. This means that a candidate who was not elected in the first round and who competed in the second round will be included as two separate observations for the corresponding election.

Description: Date of election, coded as three separate variables. The variables v2 and v3 have the code -1 (not available) when only the year of the election is available. This is only the case for elections at a popular assembly or by the cantonal Parliament. This information will be included in later versions of the data file.

Description: Dummy variable identifying elections by a Landsgemeinde.

Description: Dummy variable identifying elections by the cantonal Parliament.

Description: Dummy variable identifying candidates elected in a tacit election.

**v8 Election round**

Description: Round of the election.  
Values and labels:

1	1 <sup>st</sup> round
2	2 <sup>nd</sup> round

**v9 Number of seats to be attributed in this election**

Description: Number of seats distributed in this election. The number of seats is always the same for both rounds of the election, even if one of the two seats has already been allocated during the first round of the election. Except for supplementary elections, the number of seats is equal to the number of seats of the canton in the Council of States.

#### **v10 Main election or supplementary election?**

Description: The separation between main elections and supplementary elections was not (yet) done for elections at a Landsgemeinde.
